

**YOKOTA TOURS
POLICIES**

You must be 18 or older to sign up for a Yokota Tour. All participants 17 years and under must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to go on Yokota Tours. Please read the tour descriptions in this brochure thoroughly. Participants are encouraged to eat a good breakfast prior to departing on all morning tours; you may also bring your own food on the tours. Rest stops are made on all tours lasting over two hours. (The food at the rest stops is primarily Japanese and currency used is yen.) At all stops, we encourage passengers to return to the same seat taken at the beginning of the tour, and always return to the bus at the time directed by the tour guide. Buses for all Yokota Tours depart near building 2000. Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to departure time as buses leave promptly, rain or shine.

Full payment for the cost of the tour is due at the time of reservation and must be made in person. All payments must be made in cash, check or charge (VISA, MASTERCARD or CLUB CARD); yen will not be accepted.

Smoking and consumption of alcoholic beverages are prohibited on the tour bus. Personal coolers are acceptable but must be stored in the luggage compartment beneath the bus. Listening to media players is allowed only with the use of headphones. Parents must ensure their children are well behaved and do not disturb other passengers.

The Yokota ITT staff strive to ensure the most enjoyable trip possible. We will make every reasonable effort to accommodate groups when requested. However, due to seating and ticket availability, this may not always be possible.

The Yokota ITT Office is not responsible for the loss of personal items (baggage, equipment, etc.) left on the bus. The Yokota ITT Office is not responsible for any accidents due to personal negligence or misconduct on the tour.

All trip schedules can change due to traffic and/or other extenuating circumstances.

Prices and schedules are subject to change without notice.

YOKOTA TOUR WAIT-LIST POLICY

If the tour is full, you can put your name on a waiting list. If there are any cancellations, we will try to contact you three times via phone. After receiving the phone call, you will have 24 hours to come by the Yokota ITT Office to sign up. After the 24 hour period is over, we will move on to the next person on the list.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

All tour cancellations due to inclement weather will be determined by 4 p.m. the day before the scheduled tour. Customers will be notified by 6 p.m. that night. In the event a cancellation is necessary, charge refunds will be made the following day and cash refunds will be available after five business days. Customer receipts will be needed to pay out refunds.

YOKOTA TOURS REFUND POLICY

• **One-Day Tours**
Refund will be provided for cancellations made four or more business days prior to tour date. Any cancellations made after four business days will not be entitled to a refund.

• **Overnight Tours**
The cancellation policy will be notated on the tour book for each tour.

• **Military Obligations**
In the case of a TDY, TAD, exercise or recall, written documentation (TDY orders or letter from squadron commander/first sergeant) must be presented prior to departure for a full refund.

In the event that Yokota ITT has already purchased the admission ticket, you will have to pay for the admission ticket cost regardless of the reason for cancellation.

You must have your receipt at the time the refund is requested. No refund 30 days after the event date.

Note: For regular tours, customers are permitted to purchase up to 10 tickets per person. For special tours, customers are permitted up to five tickets per person. Group seating is not guaranteed on tours.

POLICY FOR CONDUCT AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON FSS TOUR BUSES

These guidelines will be followed for the safety and comfort of all passengers traveling aboard 374 FSS sponsored tours to include: Yokota Tours; Outdoor Recreation trips; New Sanno/Narita shuttles and all Private Organizations that contract transportation through 374 FSS Vehicle Operations. The following provisions will be followed by all customers electing to travel on a 374 FSS bus: Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in the seating and aisle area of the bus. All coolers, bags or backpacks containing alcoholic beverages must be stored within the bus luggage compartment located below and separated from the seating compartment.

A customer found in the seating area with alcoholic beverages will be directed by a 374 FSS escort to immediately move the beverages to the luggage compartment. Customers refusing to comply with the no-alcohol policy while en route will be released at the next convenient train station or location. The customer is responsible to secure their own transportation back to Fussa/Yokota.

Customers found intoxicated when boarding a 374 FSS bus for return travel to Fussa/Yokota will be refused admittance on the bus. They will be directed to the closest train station or location. Again, it is the responsibility of the intoxicated person to find another means of travel.

Persons not permitted to travel with 374 FSS due to the above circumstances shall forfeit their ability to receive a refund for incurred expenses for bus travel and event fees.

Individuals will be referred to the 374th Mission Support Group Commander for non-compliance with the above requirements. Incidents will be handled under UCMJ or YCAP as appropriate.

YOSHIDA FIRE FESTIVAL

The Yoshida Fire Festival or “Yoshida no Himatsuri” is held every year in an attempt to appease the goddess of Mount Fuji and prevent the volcano from erupting for another year. Yoshida no Himatsuri also serves as the closing ceremony of the Fujisan summer climbing season. For this lively two-day celebration — named one of Japan’s three most unique festivals and celebrated for over 500 years — the entire community comes out to watch the burning of large “taimatsu” torches and the parade of two large portable shrines called “Omikoshi.” The Fire Festival is one of Fujiyoshida’s most prized cultural possessions, and this year’s festival promises to live up to its reputation.

Enjoy all-you-can-eat blueberries for 30 minutes and take a pack to go. After blueberry picking, we will visit Mount Takago’s Monkey Zoo and see Japanese macaque monkeys. You can even feed the monkeys by purchasing food for a small fee. Then, enjoy a buffet style lunch at the Hotel Mikazuki Ryugujo with a great view of Tokyo Bay. Enjoy your choice of over 40 dishes of Japanese, Chinese and Western cuisine. After lunch, we will stop at a man-made island known as Umihotaru. Enjoy panoramic views of Tokyo Bay as you visit at the multiple shops, restaurants and services.

MATSUMOTO CASTLE, OPEN-AIR ARCHITECTURAL MUSEUM & UKIYO-E ART MUSEUM

Matsumoto Castle is the oldest castle donjon remaining in Japan. Japan’s Ukiyo-e Museum is an ultramodern building housing a private collection of the Sakai family’s woodblock prints. With more than 100,000 prints, it’s believed to be the largest collection of its kind and includes representative masterpieces of all known Ukiyo-e artists. The Matsumoto City Open-Air Architectural Museum presents five historical buildings built during the late Edo period. The main building is the former Nagano District Court which was built in 1908 and later transferred to its present location. Other buildings include the Showa Kogyo silk factory, Matsumoto Juvenile Correction Institution and a museum for exhibitions.

(Hokkaido scallops and Koshu-Fuji roast pork are one plate per person.) The next stop will be Chateau Katsunuma Winery. Take a winery tour and enjoy free wine tasting. Lastly, go peach picking with all-you-can-eat peaches.

The summer scene at the Nagano Jigokudani Monkey Park is quite different than that of the winter months. The full-leaved trees and added vegetation provide shade from the hot sun. This ideal environment brings the monkeys closer to the park as it gives them places to hide and rest. There are also wild berries, flowers and insects for them to eat. See the monkeys face to face without cages or enclosures! After the monkey park, we will stop at Shinshu Fruits Land for 30 minutes of all-you-can-eat chilled peaches. Includes two peaches for you to take home.

FUJIYOSHIDA SENGEN SHRINE, OSHINO VILLAGE & MT. FUJI LAVA CAVES

Oshino Village is a small village within the Fuji Five Lakes region characterized by eight ponds which are fed by snow melt from the slopes of nearby Mount Fuji. Water filters down the mountain through porous

layers of lava, resulting in crystal-clear springs revered by the locals. Fujiyoshida Sengen Shrine is set off by a long path lined by stone lanterns and tall cedar trees. Enjoy a buffet-style lunch at Sylvans which offers freshly baked pizzas, meat dishes, pastas, salads, desserts and more. Next, we will explore the Wind and Bat Caves, both created by Mount Fuji’s past eruptions.

This huge, spacious park is home to a variety of colorful flowers and vegetation that bloom throughout the year as well as many attractions including an amusement park, cafes, restaurants and some athletic activities. After enjoying the park, feast on an Italian buffet at the Papageno Italian Restaurant. Aquaworld Aquarium in Ibaraki is an aquarium that boasts one of the top-class aquariums in Japan. The aquarium is divided into nine zones with attractive displays of different oceans. There are also dolphin and sea lion shows for visitors to enjoy.
