ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION & BUS USE POLICIES

This policy is established to ensure the safety and comfort of all passengers traveling aboard 374th Services Division sponsored tours to include: Yokota ITT Tours; Outdoor Recreation trips; New Sanno/Narita shuttles and all Private Organizations that contract transportation through 374th Services Vehicle Operations.

Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in the passenger area of the bus. All coolers, bags, or backpacks containing alcoholic beverages must be stored within the bus luggage compartment which is not accessible from the passenger compartment.

Passengers possessing or consuming alcoholic beverages in the passenger compartment will be directed by the 374th guide/escort to immediately remove the beverage(s) to the luggage compartment. Passenger(s) refusing to comply with this policy while en route will be taken to the next convenient train station or equal location. Passenger(s) are responsible for their transportation back to Fussa/Yokota.

Intoxicated passenger(s) returning to the bus for return travel back to Fussa/Yokota will be refused admittance. They will be directed to the closest train station or equal location. Again, it is the responsibility of the intoxicated person(s) to find another means of travel.

Customer(s) who have been refused travel on a 374th Services Division bus due to any of the above circumstances shall forfeit the right to receive a refund for incurred expenses (i.e. travel and/or event fees).

Individuals will be referred to the 374th Mission Support Group Commander for non-compliance with the above requirements. Those incidents will be handled under UCMJ or YCAP as appropriate.
