

Famous for its volcanic landscapes and hot springs, Hakone National Park is one of the most popular destinations among Japanese and international tourists. See a sweeping view of the national park and Owakudani, or "Hell Valley," from the aerial cable car. You will see smoking volcanic activity and be able to sample the volcanic cooked black eggs. Enjoy a delightful boat ride across Lake Ashi. Hakone Checkpoint was utilized in the past as a vital control point along the Tokaido highway, which linked Tokyo with Kyoto during the feudal Edo period. This checkpoint prevented weapons from being brought into Tokyo, also known as Edo during the time, as well as kept women and children from fleeing. The checkpoint was in operation for more than 260 years until 1868 when the Edo period changed to the Meiji period. Founded in 757, Hakone Shrine stands at the foot of Mt. Hakone. It is known for its large red torii gate that stands near the shore with its base submerged in the waters of Lake Ashi.



Matsumoto Castle (Matsumoto-jo) is one of four castles designated as National Treasures of Japan and is the oldest castle donjon, or keep, remaining in Japan. Construction began in 1592 on this elegant black and white structure with three turrets. Because of the elegant black roof, Matsumoto Castle is sometimes called "Crow Castle." Inside the castle are steep stairs and low ceilings leading past displays of armor and weapons from the Sengoku period ("Warring States") when the castle was built. The narrow wooden windows, once used by archers and gunmen, provide amazing views of the Japanese Alps, Matsumoto City and the koi and swans circling in the moat below. Japan Ukiyo-e Museum is an ultramodern building housing the private collection of the Sakai family, quite simply one of the best museums of woodblock prints in Japan. With more than 100,000 prints, it's believed to be the largest collection of its kind in the world and includes representative masterpieces of all known Ukiyo-e artists.

This tour offers various places to explore Tokyo, perfect for a one-day getaway. You'll visit Meiji Shrine, Tsukiji marketplace and Asakusa Kannon Temple (Senso-ji) on this tour. Meiji Shrine is Japan's most famous Shinto shrine and is dedicated to the Meiji emperor and his wife. Visitors to the shrine can take part in typical Shinto activities such as buying charms and amulets or writing out a wish on an ema (wooden plaque). After visiting Meiji Shrine, walk around and experience the taste of Japan at the Tsukiji markets. It is nicknamed Tokyo's kitchen and is one of the largest marketplaces. The streets are lined with many retail shops, restaurants and much more. The last stop of the tour is Asakusa and its main attraction, the ancient Buddhist temple, Senso-ji, which was built in the 7th century. This very popular temple is approached via the Nakamise, a long shopping street that has been providing temple visitors with a variety of traditional local snacks and souvenirs for centuries.

Mishima Skywalk is the longest pedestrian suspension bridge in Japan where you can enjoy unrestricted panoramic views of the western slopes of Mt. Fuji as well as that of the Izu Mountains. The bridge is 1,312 feet long, 232 feet high and over five feet wide. The suspension tower is equally as impressive, standing at 144 feet. Odawara Castle was originally built in the mid-15th century and soon fell into the hands of the Hojo Clan, one of the most powerful clans during the Warring States period. In 1590, Toyotomi Hideyoshi attacked the castle and, with the defeat of the Hojo Clan, reunited Japan. 




